- University Senate's USGC is still preparing and debating a report and a resolution to be presented for a vote at the <u>Senate meetings in 2020-2021</u>.

Chair's report

- Resolution on the Course Atlas Appeal to the University Senate.
- On May 27, 2020, Senate Appeals Panel has concluded its work in researching and deliberating the appeal submitted by the New Brunswick Faculty Council on the Implementation of Course Atlas.
- Informed NBFC Chair that the Panel upheld the appeal and issued a report.

The majority view of the Panel was that, overall, there was a practice well established of consulting faculty in such matters that would require consultation in this case; and the majority view of the Panel was that, overall, consultation in this case was not adequate.

It is the decision of the Senate Appeals Panel that this appeal be upheld.
