Synchronous	4785	48.6%
Asynchronous	5067	51.4%

* “Other” = Thesis, independent study, and other by-arrangement class sections that may or may not enroll students in the fall semester, and do not meet on a regular basis.

Preparing Faculty and Students for Remote Instruction

Faculty:

- Working with CTAAR, TLT, and School-based teaching and learning teams to provide resources and professional development opportunities.

Students (enrollment data as of 9/15):

- “How to Succeed in Online Learning” – Asynchronous course via Canvas
 - 6,409 students enrolled
- Learning Center Tutoring – Drop-in via Penji (on-line platform)
 - 514 sign-ups; 170 visits
- Learning Center Study Groups – Register online; meet via Penji
 - 564 enrolled
